





2024 Secondary (Excess) Accident Insurance Claims Filing Instructions

Lincoln Technical Institute has obtained a Secondary (Excess) Accident Insurance policy in the event that a student is injured during an eligible event and will require outside medical treatment. An Injury Claim form will be submitted on behalf the student to Mutual of Omaha, the Claims Company for the accident insurance policy.



Please be advised that this coverage is excess (secondary in most situations) to all other valid and collectable insurance plans. Each student should initially provide their primary health insurance information to each medical provider at the time of treatment, as well as the Secondary (Excess) Accident insurance information. This policy is designed to cover any remaining balances of expenses related to a covered injury/accident that are not covered by the student's primary insurance (including co-pays, deductibles, coinsurance, etc.) and left to patient responsibility.

To ensure that claims are covered under the Secondary (Excess) Accident Insurance students are asked to give the billing information to each medical provider prior to every medical treatment and/or service for an eligible injury.
